I hope you are both well.

As discussed earlier, we will be implementing one of the country's most advanced, efficient and effective political programs this election cycle. We are hoping to hire people in the King/Snohomish/Pierce/Clark/Spokane Counties who are dedicated to changing the direction of our state by making a difference in the upcoming elections. The success of our program will hinge largely upon the quality of people we hire to walk key legislative districts. We will have teams of 5 walkers and one team captain in each legislative district. These teams will collect voter information via door-to-door contact. We will fully train team members and captains. What's more, we will handsomely pay these team members for performing what are normally volunteer activities. In fact, team captains will receive \$12/hr and team members \$10/hr. They will have the opportunity to work up to 24 hours/week (4-8 p.m. M-F and 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Sat). In addition, we will provide regular incentives. We are looking for dedicated, dependable people preferably 16 years of age or older. As discussed, we firmly believe this presents a tremendous opportunity for homeschoolers to be a part of a precedent setting political program while making a significant difference in the political process this year.
